As per Governor Newsom's Executive Order # N-29-20 signed on March 17, 2020, Item 3. Paragraph 11 of Executive Order N-25-20 (March 12, 2020) is withdrawn and superseded by the following text:

Notwithstanding any other provision of state or local law (including, but not limited to, the Bagley-Keene Act or the Brown Act), and subject to the notice and accessibility requirements set forth below, a local legislative body or state body is authorized to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to observe and to address the local legislative body or state body. All requirements in both the Bagley-Keene Act and the Brown Act expressly or impliedly requiring the physical presence of members, the clerk or other personnel of the body, or of the public as a condition of participation in or quorum for a public meeting are hereby waived.

- (i) State and local bodies notice each teleconference location from which a member will be participating in a public meeting;
- (ii) Each teleconference location be accessible to the public;
- (iii) Members of the public may address the body at each teleconference conference location;
- (iv) State and local bodies post agendas at all teleconference locations;
- (v) At least one member of the state body be physically present at the location specified in the notice of the meeting; and
- (vi) During teleconference meetings, at least a quorum of the members of the local body participate from locations within the boundaries of the territory over which the local body exercises jurisdiction

Are hereby suspended.

The Board of Trustees values your comments. Pursuant to Board Bylaw No. 9323, each individual speaker shall be allowed three minutes to address the Board on each agenda or nonagenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public input on each item to 20 minutes.

In accordance with the agreement between the California School Employees Association and its Rosemead Chapter 9 (CSEA) and the Rosemead School District (RSD), CSEA proposes the following conceptual modifications, additions, or deletions to the current collective bargaining agreement between the respective parties.

CSEA reserves the right to advance other additions, deletions, and interests during this Reopener negotiations on all Articles and or Appendices. CSEA intends to negotiate the following:

Article 9- Salaries

CSEA intends to enhance the lives of our members by negotiating an on-going salary increase for all bargaining unit members.

Article 10- Health & Welfare

CSEA intends to negotiate for an increase in the District's contribution in an attempt to reduce the out-of-pocket contribution for all eligible classified employees and family members for medical, dental, vision, and life coverage levels.
