4. Article XIX – Evaluation Procedure and Calendar

The District proposes new language concerning evaluation procedures to the bargaining unit that ensures an objective and collaborative process, which supports professional growth and improved practices for certificated teachers in accordance with the California Standards for the Teaching Profession (CSTP).
