I. NOTICES - Public Comments / Speaker's Requests

Given the continuing COVID-19 state of emergency, and with Governor Newsom's Executive Order #N-29-20 signed on March 17, 2020 and Executive Order #N-08-21 signed on June 11, 2021, regarding relaxed teleconferencing provisions sunsetting on September 30, 2021, the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees will adopt new procedures to continue holding public meetings through teleconferencing pursuant to Assembly Bill ("AB") 361.

AB 361, signed into law on September 16, 2021, amends Government Code section 54953, authorizing the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees to conduct meetings under AB 361's abbreviated teleconferencing procedures when the Board holds a meeting during a declared state of emergency, as defined under the California Emergency Services Act Government Code section 8625, and state or local health officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, during a proclaimed state of emergency for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, or during a proclaimed state of emergency when the Board has already determined by majority vote that holding the meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of safety of attendees, subject to compliance with the requirements set forth in Government Code section 54953(e)(2).

If you wish to address the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees during the meeting, you may either submit a written request with your full name and comments by emailing <u>board@rosemead.k12.ca.us</u> by 6:30 p.m. on the date of the meeting or provide your comments in real time (via Zoom Meeting) to the Board directly. Comments by members of the public during the meeting will be included in the official minutes.

All written requests should include: Speaker's name, address, and topic. A District representative will call on each speakers to afford an opportunity to provide their comments in real time or elect to have them read aloud by a District Representative.

The Board of Trustees values your comments. Pursuant to the Brown Act, Government Code 54954.2, 54954.3, and Education Code 35145.5, the Board cannot take any action or discuss a topic of concern until such time as the matter may appear as an item on a forthcoming agenda. Pursuant to Board Bylaw No. 9323, each individual speaker shall be allowed three minutes to address the Board on each agenda or non-agenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public input on each item to 20 minutes.

Rosemead Teachers Association Initial Proposal To the Rosemead School District 2021-2022

Under the Educational Employees Relations Act (EERA), all initial proposals of the Rosemead Teachers which relate to matters within the scope of representation, must be presented at a public meeting in order to establish and maintain open dialogue and communication in connection with the subjects to be negotiated, the Association expresses interests in discussing the following:

Calendar for the 2022-2023 schol year

Article XVIII – Economic Agreement (including salary, stipends, extra duty compensation, benefits, retiree benefits, etc.)

Article 11.3 Bereavement Leave - RTA would like to change the timeline from within the current school year to one calendar year from the time of death of the family member.

Planning Time

<u>Elementary Teachers</u> - RTA proposes that planning time for elementary school teachers gets put into the contract so they are guaranteed the time and that it's equitable district wide. Additionally, RTA would like to propose that elementary teachers get release days to work on assessments and/or planning.

Muscatel - RTA would like to clarify language on planning time and PLC meetings.
